



## Visitation Guidelines at Hilaire Rehab and Nursing

**Tuesdays – Thursdays– Fridays**

**10:30 am – 11:00 AM & 2:00 PM-2:30 PM**

1. All visitation will be by appointment only.
2. All visits must be scheduled through our Recreation Department.

3. Scheduling must be done within 7 days of visit and at least 1 day in advance.
4. All visitation sessions will be no more than 30 minutes.
5. No more than 2 visitors per session. Visitors 18 years of age or younger must be accompanied by an adult 18 years or over.
6. All general visitation is limited to the designated area in front of the building only.
7. Visits are subject to cancelation due to inclement weather.
8. Please arrive 15 min early for check-in which includes temperature check & screening.  
Do not enter facility.  
**Please do not visit if you have:**
  - Fever or respiratory symptoms, such as cough or sore throat.
  - Traveled within the last 14 days to restricted areas as defined by NYS.
  - Had contact with someone who has COVID-19.
9. Prior to visitation being permitted, all visitors must have a documented negative COVID-19 test resulted from within the past 7 days and must be presented upon entry.
10. At present time a COVID-19 antibody test is not an approved test for visitation.
11. For the safety of our residents, visitors must sanitize hands upon entry.
12. For the safety of our residents, visitors must remain 6 feet from residents at all times.
13. Visitors must bring their own face mask and wear it at all times. If you do not have an acceptable mask, one will be provided.
14. At present time there is a maximum of 1 in-person visit weekly per resident to ensure all family members and loved ones have the opportunity to safely visit their loved ones.
15. Dropping off or picking up personal items will not take place during visitation session.  
All items must go through Reception as usual.
16. All visitors must check-out upon leaving.
17. As per regulation, if any visitor fails to adhere to the protocol, they will be prohibited from visiting for the duration of the COVID-10 public health emergency.

Patio visitation remains tentative and may be temporarily discontinued due to COVID-19. We hope to expand the visitation days and times in the near future. We look forward to connecting you with your loved one.
